6. Number of entrants in competition

(1) Singles up to 128 participants

These 128 participants are made up of the following;

As 6 teams of 3 members each are to be invited from 6 countries, 18 of these single places are filled by entrants outside Japan.

One member of each local triple team can participate in the singles tournament making up the remaining 110 places in the singles competition.

(2) Triples up to 128 teams

These 128 teams are made up of the following;

Local to Japan 122 teams

Overseas guest 6 teams. (To be arranged)

7. Rules and Method of Competition

(1) Competition Rules

All events will be conducted in accordance with JPBF Rules of Petanque.

(2) Technical Delegate

(3) Competition Regulations

*The qualifying round (in both singles and triples) is played by the pool method.

The draw for the qualifying round, except for the guest teams, takes place at the reception.

In the qualifying round, each group contains by 4 teams. The team that wins two matches advances to the tournament A. The team that loses two matches advances to the tournament B. The first team to reach 11 points wins.

*The final tournament (in both singles and triples) is played by 32 teams.

The first team to reach 11 points wins, however in the semifinal and final matches the winning team is required to reach 13 points to win.

9. Eligibility

Members of JPBF or petanque enthusiasts.

*The petanque enthusiasts are eligible to participate providing that they live in the prefectures of Kyoto, Osaka, Hyogo, Nara, Wakayama, Shiga, Tottori, Tokushima and Fukui.

10. Age Requirement

11. Medal Ceremony

The Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second and third-placed athletes by each event.

*The Bronze medal match will not take place.
